Cille Holse is a dedicated and accomplished podiatrist and owns and operates in her own clinic. Since qualifying as a podiatrist in 2012, she has built a strong professional profile combining clinical expertise, leadership, research, and education.

In October 2023, she was elected Chairman of the Danish Association of Podiatrists, reflecting her commitment to advancing the profession and advocating for both practitioners and patients nationwide.

Alongside her clinic work, she serves as a podiatrist at the residential facility, where she provides regular care. Her clinical experience spans a wide range of settings, including previous roles at the Orthopaedic Wound Centre at Slagelse Hospital and at a specialist clinic under Steno Diabetes Center Zealand, focusing on psychologically vulnerable patients with diabetes.

Her professional excellence was recognized in 2021 when she was named Podiatrist of the Year. She has also contributed to the development of the field through her involvement in a research project on children's feet, conducted in collaboration between the Danish Association of Podiatrists and the Orthopaedic Surgery Department at Rigshospitalet.

In addition to her clinical and research work, she has played an active role in professional governance as a politically elected member of the regional cooperation committee for podiatry in Region Zealand, dealing with matters related to collective agreements. She has also contributed to education as a former lecturer in the podiatry training programme.
